

REVIEW ANSWERS AND EXPLANATIONS

CORRECT ANSWER

Acquitted, because she did not intend to hit anyone with her car.

EXPLANATION

The patient should be acquitted because she did not intend to hit anyone with her car. Although the patient may have been guilty of murder had the pedestrian been killed, it does not necessarily follow that she is guilty of attempted murder when she almost killed the pedestrian. Murder does not require the intent to kill; an awareness of unjustifiably high risk to human life will suffice. Like all attempt crimes, attempted murder is a specific intent crime. Thus, the intent to kill is required. Because the patient did not intend to kill the pedestrian, she cannot be convicted of attempted murder.

IV. INCHOATE OFFENSES

D. ATTEMPT

A criminal attempt is an act that, although done with the intention of committing a crime, falls short of completing the crime. An attempt therefore consists of two elements: (i) a specific intent to commit, and (ii) an overt act of furtherance of that intent.

1. Inten

The defendant must have the intent to perform an act and obtain a result that, if achieved, would constitute a crime.

a. Attempt Requires Specific Intent

Regardless of the intent required for a completed offense, an attempt always requires a specific intent. For example, attempted murder requires the specific intent to kill another person, even though the mens rea for murder itself does not necessarily require a specific intent to kill (see VII. C.2.a.l). infra).

FORMAT

The summer Washington bar exam will be the Uniform Bar Exam (UBE) that includes a six-question Multistate Essay Exam (MEE), two 90-minute Multistate Performance Test (MPT) questions and the Multistate Bar Exam (MBE), a 200-question, multiple-choice exam.

In addition to the Uniform Bar Exam, applicants must take and pass the Washington Law Component (WLC), which is an online, open book, multiple-choice test on Washington-specific law.

MPRE

The MPRE (Multistate Professional Responsibility Exam) is a 50-question, multiple-choice exam on professional responsibility that can be taken before or after the bar exam. Washington's pass score on the MPRE will be 85. Students can sit for the MPRE while in their second or third year of law school during the November, March or August administration of the exam. MPRE preparation is included in the BARBRI course price.
